How to Download an Official Copy of Your FCC License

Per FCC Public Notice 20-126, the FCC no longer mails paper copies of license authorizations.

All official license copies are now provided electronically through the FCC Universal Licensing System (ULS).

Steps to Download Your License from ULS:

1. Visit https://wireless2.fcc.gov/UlsEntry/licManager/login.jsp Log in using your FCC Registration Number (FRN) and password. Log In

- 2. If you do not know your FRN, you can search by call sign here: https://wireless2.fcc.gov/UlsApp/UlsSearch/searchLicense.jsp
- 3. If you do not know your password, you must create an FCC Username Account and associate your FRN with that account.
- 4. After logging in, locate the "My Licenses" section. You will see a green box with a link to download your Official License Copy.



5. Use the Filter by Radio Service box to select your Amateur (HV) license. Locate your call sign, select it, and click Add.



6. Scroll down and click Download.

The FCC will generate a PDF containing the official copy of your license.
